We opened the market on August 6th, 1991 beginning just with the first floor. We renovated the upper floors the next year as more and more dealers wished to rent space.

I am happy to say that we still have several dealers who have been with us since the beginning and have staff who have been with us either from the beginning or for more than 20 years.

During our 30-year life, we have gone through several life-changing events that have changed the way and type of antiques that are purchased at the Market: the advent of EBAY, 9-11, a deep recession, the construction of hotels and the MBTA green-line extension around the building, and most recently COVID.
